

## **Information Management challenges and successes on Sakhalin II Topsides**

Sakhalin II represents a \$20 billion offshore oil and gas project with world-wide execution centres & numerous organisations creating many challenges & issues.

This paper looks at how an integrated AMEC, SEIC and SHAREcat Information Management Team, used innovative processes, procedures & technology, to overcome the various obstacles that arose during the execution of the topsides facilities scope.

Success of the project was measured by the ability to deliver the **required** engineering and vendor data & documentation **when** and **where** it was needed by the Design, Construction, Completions, Commissioning, Maintenance Management & Operations Teams. This included the final handover to SEIC of over 80,000 engineering & vendor documents and some 90,000 tags, with in excess of 1 million data attributes.
