

## **Speaker Biodata: Rosli Abdul Hamid**

Mr. Rosli Abdul Hamid is currently the VP of Operation & Technical in Teknik Janakuasa Sendirian Berhad, a subsidiary of Malakoff Berhad, which is a leading “blue-chip” Independent Power Producer listed in the Kuala Lumpur Main Stock Exchange. As part of his current portfolio, he spearheaded the Lifecycle Asset Information Management (LCAIM) initiative for Malakoff Berhad in ensuring the management and availability of all information, in the form of structured data for power plants either owned or operated and maintained by Malakoff Berhad. Currently Malakoff Berhad owned 4 power stations in Malaysia with a total generating capacity of 4393MW. Included in the portfolio are Lumut Power Plant, the largest Combined Cycle Gas Turbine (CCGT) power plant in the Malaysia with an installed capacity of 1943 MW and Tanjung Bin Power Plant , a 2100MW coal fired power plant , which recently has achieved Commercial operation.

Having recognized the fact that Malakoff Berhad is the developer of power plant and one of its wholly owned subsidiaries, Teknik Janakuasa (TJSB)- a service based company for Power Plant O&M, Rosli saw the needs to bridge the knowledge and information from the EPC phase to the operating phase of the Power Plant. A pilot project on the asset lifecycle was done at Lumut Power Plant with great success which prompted the Malakoff management to implement similar exercise for a 2100MW Tanjung Bin Power Plant. His initiative has put Malakoff Berhad as the pioneer on world-class Lifecycle Asset Information Management project in the region.

Mr. Rosli graduated from Monash University, Melbourne, Australia in 1986 with a Bachelor in Engineering (Hons) in Electrical and Computer System. He started his career in Malaysia’s largest electric utility company TNB for 8 years before joining TJSB in 1994. He was involved in the plant design review for Lumut Power Plant before assuming the role of section head for Instrumentation maintenance section once the plant is completed. Later he was promoted to Head of Technical Support Group and transferred to TJSB Head office overseeing the O&M Power Plant portfolio in year 2000. He worked under various capacities in Malakoff either as plant owner or operator until recently promoted to Vice-President of Operation & Technical in the O&M Division, Malakoff Berhad. Mr. Rosli is a member of Institution of Engineers, Malaysia.
